Homework is assigned to help students become more self-reliant, complete assigned projects and to learn to work independently. Use the following Homework Tips to help you be successful:

1. **Get Organized.** Use your School Agenda to note: a) the assignment given b) date it was assigned c) date due d) date you completed assignment
2. **Set aside a specific time and place for doing your homework.** Even if you have no written assignment, use your daily study time to review class notes, textbook, etc.
3. **Avoid distractions.** Try to find a place and time when TV, radio, telephone calls, etc, will not disturb you. This will help you to finish your work more quickly and have more leisure time to devote to those activities you enjoy.
4. **Reward yourself.** When you finish your work for one class and are about to begin work on the next class, take a short break, stretch, move around, get a little fresh air.
5. **Hand your homework in!** Some students complete the work only to find they do not have it when they get to class. Find a filing system that works for you such as a three ring binder with labeled dividers for each class.
6. **Check all on-line assignments and grades regularly.** This is a great way to assist you in staying current on all class work/ homework and provide timely communication to our families.
